SATSANGS CONDUCTED IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF INDIA- We had conducted a Satsang, probably the first in Chennai, which is mainly a non- hindi speaking area. It was done in affiliation with the local church there and the target audience was people from the north of India who have migrated to Chennai in huge numbers over the last decade. There was a tremendous response and the hall which could accommodate around 2000 people saw more than 600 new people who heard the gospel for the first time.

There was also a Satsang conducted in Ulhas Nagar, MS in September last year and we are having a follow up in the same place on the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

We want that the seed sown can be nurtured by the local churches there.

We intend to have such Satsangs on a regular basis around Maharashtra so that we can win new souls and build a new congregation in the adjoining areas of Mumbai and our heart is to use this format to plant new churches in future. Please pray that as we are setting some challenging goals, with the Lord's help we shall be able to achieve it.
